Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) - Embracing Maria Montessori's vision of the developmental stages of the child, and with-in a prepared environment (the atrium), the CGS catechist offers presentations based on aspects of the Bible and Liturgy. The child's personal work using materials provided enables further meditation on the mysteries addressed by the presentations, inviting the child to hear and follow Jesus' voice, remain in Jesus, and build the Kingdom of God.

- For children ages 3 years (by September 1st) 9 years
- Children meet weekly with a CGS catechist in an atrium
- Sessions run September through May and follow the HFCS Calendar
- ♦ There are 2 levels:

Level 1: 3-6 year olds

Wed. 10:45 am - 12:00 pm Thurs. 4:30 pm - 6:00 pm Level II: 6-9 year olds

Tues. 2:30-4:00 pm Wed. 4:30-6:00 pm

NOTE: Children enrolled in Holy Family Classical School attend CGS atrium sessions during the school day up to 2nd grade; no need to register
